

Do you qualify for veterans benefits?

## act dallas act austin are approved to train veterans for teacher certification!

To determine your VA benefits, call the **VA Education toll-free: 1-888-442-4551 (1-888-GI Bill 1)** ACT is only approved for Montgomery GI Bill (Ch. 30) & Post 9/11 (Ch. 33) benefits. Your military benefits will pay for:

\$600 Preparation Program Institute Fee \$3650-\$3850 Internship OR \$3000 Clinical Teaching Fee

Veterans must provide ACT Dallas or Austin with the following documents:

- DD-214 <u>www.archives.gov/veterans/evetrecs/index.html</u>
- Military Transcripts <u>https://jst.doded.mil</u> Reminder - an "official" <u>transcript</u> is not needed. A photocopy or computer permission to view will suffice!
- Certificate of Eligibility for Post 9/11 Benefits Regional Office in Muskogee 1-888-442-4551

## Additional information:

- Veterans who qualify for Post 9/11 benefits must have a **Certificate of Eligibility** specifying the % amount of their benefits and the length of time the benefits are available.
- Post 9/11 benefits (Chapter 33) are sent directly to the ACT Financial office. The veteran does not receive them, although the veteran may receive a housing allowance or other additional amount that is sent to their residence.
- Post 9/11 benefits are for the exact amount of the ACT fees:

\$75 Application Fee must be paid by the veteran. Is not eligible for veterans benefits (Post 9/11 or Montgomery GI Bill)
\$600 Preparation Program Institute Fee
\$2450\* \$2850\* Internation Fee

\$3650\* - \$3850\* Internship Fee \*Plus \$2 - \$4 Service Fee \$3000 Clinical Teaching Fee

- Montgomery GI Bill benefits (Chapter 30) are sent to the veteran. The veteran is responsible for paying all fees directly and in a timely manner to ACT.
- When ACT receives all of the military documents, Dr. Bobette Dunn will certify the veteran's enrollment and submit info to the VA for payment.
